

Bike tour to the **Feldberg**

(Highest Point of the Black Forest) 56 km, approx. 4,5 - 6 hours

Start in Wieden, 850 m follow the L 123 up hill for about 2km then turn right to Ungendwieden.

Follow the green bike sign towards Muggenbrunn. Follow the woodland path until you reach Gschwender Hölzle. Out of the Woods and go down towards the first Houses and take the first small road on your left towards the Notschrei. (1120m)

When you reach the Notschrei Hotel, cross the road and take the woodland path behind the Hotel which will bring you towards the Biathlon Training centre. Just before you reach the centre turn slightly right and take a light descent.

Take the second turn on your left after about 2 km; this path takes you around a beautiful side valley and later to the well-known village of Todtnauberg. (1019m)

There you can see your next challenge, the white chapel below the forest.

From there it is quite a long way up towards the Feldberg, because it gets steeper towards the End.

When you get to the top you follow the path towards the Todtnauer Hütte(1319m)

where you can have a nice break on the terrace with a stunning view over the Wiesental Valley.

This was the hardest bit of the tour. From the Todtnauer Hütte follow the signs for Stübenwasen,

To get there you have to climb a few short but steep stretches and be careful going down on the other side, the bumps on the path are quite dangerous if go over them too fast.

Stübenwasen is also a good restaurant if you fancy a break. From Stübenwasen it is back to the Notschrei, from there follow the Main road to Halde where your next turn is to the left.

Direction to the Wiedener Eck, mainly woodpath, not too hard, when you reach the Böden Hütte, built by English Pioneers turn left again until you get to Gschwender Hölzle again , from there it is all the way down (20 min.) to Wieden.
